*RE: Implementation of New Docketing System for Insurance Insolvency Cases*

**PER CURIAM**

**ORDER**

AND NOW, this 9<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2012, in accordance with the Court's new docketing system for insurance insolvency cases, the Court hereby ORDERS:

1. The above-captioned matter, currently entitled *Michael F. Consedine, Insurance Commissioner of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Plaintiff v. Penn Treaty Network America Insurance Company, Defendant* and docketed at No. 5 M.D. 2009, shall be entitled *In Re: Penn Treaty Network America Insurance Company in Rehabilitation* and shall be docketed at No. 1 PEN 2009. All filings relating to the administration of the main Penn Treaty Network America Insurance Company estate in rehabilitation shall be filed with the new caption and docket number.

2. In addition, under the new docketing system, ancillary matters in the form of actions related to the rehabilitation that would have previously been assigned a separate miscellaneous docket number or previously been docketed to No. 5 M.D. 2009, such as actions asserted by certain intervenors shall be assigned separate docket numbers in the "Penn Treaty" (PEN) docket. At the present time, one such ancillary matter is pending. The case currently entitled *Michael F. Consedine, Insurance Commissioner of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in his official capacity as Rehabilitator of Penn Treaty Network America Insurance Company, Plaintiff v. Penn Treaty American Corporation, Defendant* and docketed at 451 M.D. 2010, shall be captioned in conformance with the example in Exhibit 1 and shall be docketed at No. 1 PEN 2010. The caption shall retain the party names as they currently appear and there shall be added the parenthetical "(Ancillary to In Re: Penn Treaty Network America Insurance Company in Rehabilitation, No, 1 PEN 2009)."

3. Subsequently filed ancillary matters shall contain a caption substantially in compliance with the example in Exhibit 1. Insofar as prior case management orders prescribe a different caption format, the prior orders are superseded.

4. At the commencement of any ancillary matter, not relating to the administration of the main Penn Treaty Network America Insurance Company estate in rehabilitation and not docketed to No. 1 PEN 2009, the party initiating the

ancillary matter shall complete the cover sheet set forth in Exhibit 2 and file it with the Chief Clerk.
